## YOUTH FISHING AWARD

The BC Wildlife Federation "Youth Fishing Award" is open to youth members of the Federation who are 18 years of age or younger and who have caught the fish in British Columbia.

### Rules:

- Must be a fish caught in British Columbia.
- All entries must have been caught in the calendar year **from January 1 to December 31, 2018**.
- May be a catch and release or retention.
- Must have picture of fish and angler.
- Must have the name and birth date of entrant.
- Must have species, weight, date caught, and name of lake, stream or ocean.
- Must be witnessed.
- **ONLY MEMBERS OF THE FEDERATION IN GOOD STANDING MAY ENTER. MEMBERSHIP MUST BE PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THE FISH BEING CAUGHT.**

All species entered will be compared to the North American record book. The entry scoring the highest percentage in comparison to the record in that category will win.

**Special Note:** Any Youth entered in the BCWF Youth Fishing Award is automatically entered into the Lee Straight Award.
