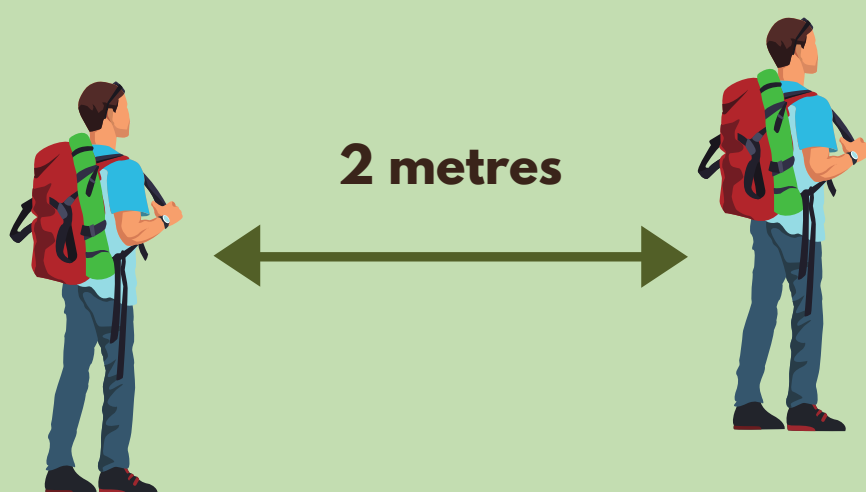


# We can all still enjoy hunting and angling activities in B.C. ...

... BUT WITH JUST A FEW MORE PRECAUTIONS

## STAY SAFE TOGETHER

Only fish and hunt with the people who share your household. Do not share vehicles with anyone who doesn't live with you.



## KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

Maintain physical distancing (2 metres or 6 feet) from other individuals you come across.

## STAY LOCAL

Fish and hunt locally. Adhere to all travel advisories and self isolation requirements.



## WASH YOUR HANDS

Wash your hands frequently, especially around communal areas such as boat ramps, gates, etc.

## EXPECT CLOSURES

Adhere to all municipal, First Nation community, provincial and federal closures. Many B.C. Parks are open for day-use only at this phase. It is suggested to check ahead.
