

2024 Provincial Election Town Hall **PUT WILDLIFE FIRST**

Many of British Columbia's fish and wildlife populations are in decline.

Species such as steelhead and caribou are at **risk of extinction**. Action is needed to keep common species such as moose, mule deer and mountain sheep from the same fate. Key watersheds and habitats are in peril.

Worse, the proportion of B.C.'s budget allocated for natural resource management has been in decline for 50 years, leaving wildlife **chronically underfunded**.

This must change before we have any chance to reverse the damage.

The B.C. Wildlife Federation is demanding change before our iconic wildlife species disappear forever.

We are hosting a **Town Hall** near you. Engage with your local candidates to demand:

- Wildlife management must be conducted by an agency independent of government influence.
- Funding dedicated to fish and wildlife should be increased and driven by legislated objectives.
- Public access to public resources must be enshrined in law.
