Outdoor Heritage and Conservation

Will you commit to a National Hunting, Trapping and Angling strategy to support Canada's outdoors heritage?

Will you act to use a portion of the GST on goods related to hunting, fishing, and trapping to fund wildlife conservation?

Chronic Wasting Disease

Will you commit to a ban on transporting live deer, elk, and moose across provincial and international boundaries?

Will you take action to wind down cervid farming to protect wild populations?

Public Access to Protected Areas

Will you act to preserve public access to protected areas for angling, hunting, hiking, and camping for all Canadians?

Will you commit to setting harvest restrictions only when needed to preserve the sustainability of wildlife populations?

Will you commit to permanent funding for detection and rapid response to aquatic invasive species?
